HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:

1

Pick your script!

Pick from the Top 5 *100(ish) Word Plays*. You can download the scripts on our website, or email mile@atc.co.nz to get your hands on them. Check them out in motion in our Instagram highlights - [@atc_youtharts](https://www.instagram.com/atc_youtharts)

2

Pick your category!

Include at least one of the category elements in your video. The very best in each category may be selected to be screened.

- **MOST INVENTIVE** – how theatrical can you be with technology?
- **BEST COSTUME** - Spice it up with some crazy costumes!
- **BEST USE OF A HOUSEHOLD OBJECT FOR A FUNCTION IT WAS NOT INTENDED** – use a fork for a hairbrush Little Mermaid style!?
- **BEST USE OF FAMILY MEMBER OR PET** – Not the only member of your family with a flair for the arts? Get your families and furry friends creating with you!
- **MOST UNEXPECTED USE OF A BODY PART** – Get kooky and weird... but keep it PG!
